

“A real pain in the neck! - Oropharyngeal Stick Injuries”

The lecture will provide an overview of this not uncommon injury, discuss the reasons why they are classified as acute and chronic and then cover the investigations and management struggles for each. The talk will be case based, practical and relevant to small animal practitioners and hopefully provide some tips that can immediately be taken back to their practice.



Aidan graduated from UCD in 2003 with a first class honors Bachelor of Veterinary Medicine Degree. After a period in general practice he returned to the University Veterinary Hospital UCD to undertake an ECVS residency in small animal surgery.
